

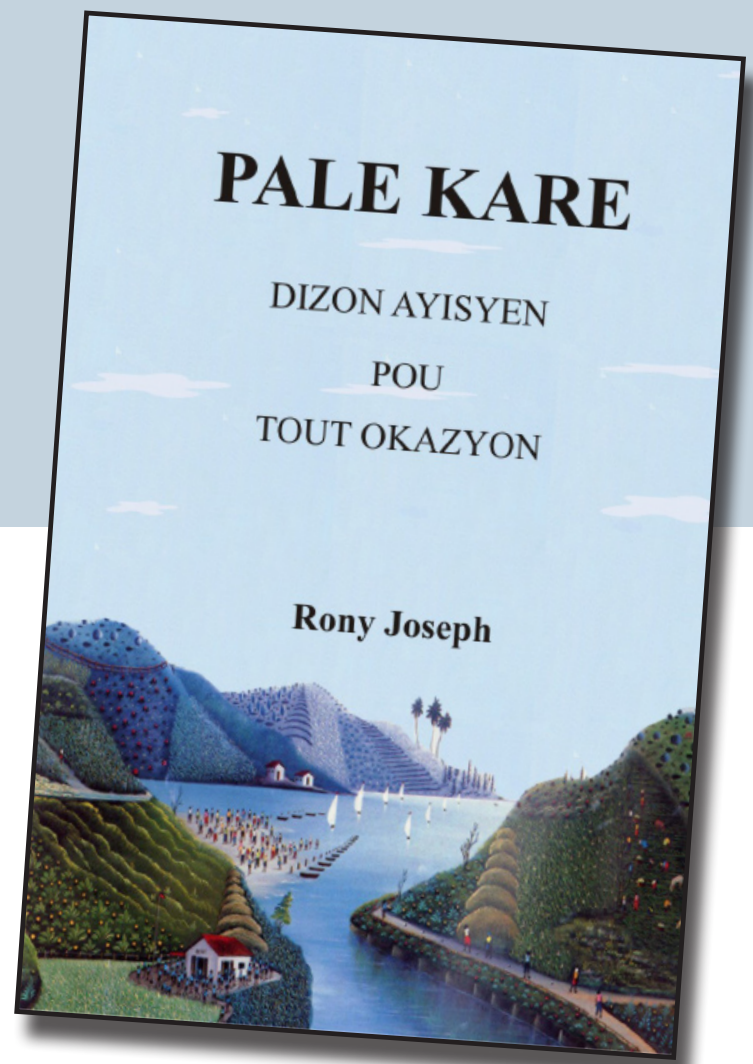
Book Signing Event

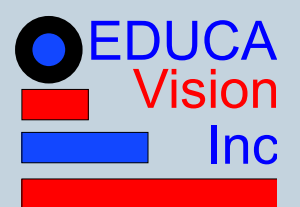
drawn from settings that are familiar to the Haitian Creole speakers. This is a book of great educational value to anyone who speaks or who is interested in the Haitian Creole language.
